## Zaajqha 16 – Chivkeeb Tshooj 18

### Nrug Vaajtswv Thaam Conversation With God

Tam nuav tsi muaj ntau lub tebchaws kws muaj vaajntxwv (*king*) lawm. Tabsis tebchaws Thaib tseem yog ib lub tebchaws kws muaj vaajntxwv hab cov pejxeem Thaib fwm puab tug vaajntxwv heev. Txawm kuv (Kx. Txawj Teev) tub moog Thaibteb ntau zag lawm los kuv yeej tsi tau pum, tsi tau ntsib, hab tsi tau nrug vaajntxwv Thaib thaam ib zag le. Cov Moob nyob Thabteb los feem coob yeej tsi tau ntsib vaajntxwv hlo le hab. Tub tsi has Moob, tug Thaib kag los feem coob yeej tsi tau ntsib vaajntxwv tim ntsej tim muag le.

Vaajtswv yog tug tsim ntuj tsim teb hab tsim ib puas tsaav yaam. Noobneej le koj hab kuv yeej tsi tau muaj leejtwg pum Vaajtswv hlo le. Tabsis lawv le Chivkeeb tshooj 18 mas Anplahaas yog thawj tug tuabneeg hab yog tug xaus kws tau pum hab nrug Vaajtswv thaam tim ntsej tim muag. Es ob tug sis thaam txug dlaabtsi? Vaajtswv tug coojpwm zoo le caag? Vaajtswv xaav le caag txug tej teebmeem huv nplajteb? Nyeem kuas taagnrho Chivkeeb tshooj 18, uantej teb cov lug nug nuav.

*Today, very few countries still have kings. Thailand is one of those countries and the Thai citizens respect the King very much. Although I (Pastor Timothy Vang) has been to Thailand many times, I have not seen, met, or had conversation with the King. Most of the Hmong in Thailand have never met the King either. Even the Thai, most of them have never met the King.*

*God is the creator of everything. Human beings like us have never seen God. But in Genesis 18, we read that Abraham was the first and the last person who had met God and talked to Him face to face. What did they talk about? What was God's character? What did God think about the problems of this world? Read the whole chapter of Genesis 18 before answering these questions.*

2. Lawv le nqai 10 hab nqai 17 has, peb tug txivneej nuav muaj ib tug yog leejtwg?  
*According to verses 10 and 17, who was one of these three men?*

3. Anplahaas txuj kev tam qhua zoo le Moob hab txawv le Moob txuj kev tam qhua le caag? (Nqai 3-8).  
*What are some of the similarities and differences from Abraham's custom of entertaining guests to those of the Hmong? (Verses 3-8).*

4. Yog ib tug quaspuj has tas lawv le Chivkeeb 18:14, tsi muaj ib yaam kws Vaajtswv ua tsi tau le, yog ua caag nwg tub thov Vaajtswv heev lawm tabsis nwg pheej xeeb tsi taug mivnyuas le, koj yuav teb le caag?  
*If a woman said that according to Genesis 18:14, nothing is too hard for God, she has prayed, but has not been able to conceive, what would be your answer?*

6. Feem ntau ntawm peb cov pawg ntseeg yeej tsi mob sab txug tej teebmeem kws tshwmsim huv lub zejzog. Tabsis lawv le cov lug kws Vaajtswv hab Anplahaas sis thaam nuav, koj totaub tas Vaajtswv xaav le caag txug noobneej tej teebmeem?

*Most churches have no concerns for the problems in the society. But according to the conversation between God and Abraham, what do you understand about God's concerns for the problems in the society?*

Yauhaas 4:24 has tas Vaajtswv yog ntsujplig. Tabsis Chivkeeb 18 has tas peb (3) tug txivneej kws lug ntsib Anplahaas ntawd ib tug yog Vaajtswv. Peb ntseeg tas muaj ob qhov kws peb yuav txhais zaaj nuav:

1. Peb (3) tug kws lug ntsib Anplahaas ntawd yeej yog timtswv xwb, tabsis muaj ib tug yog tug sawv kev Vaajtswv – nwg has Vaajtswv cov lug.
2. Peb (3) tug txivneej ntawd ib tug yeej yog Vaajtswv tag, tabsis yog Vaajtswv hloov cev ua noobneej lawm. Vaajtswv muaj peevxwm ua tau txhua yaam. Txawm Nwg yog ntsujplig los Nwg yeej muaj peevxwm hloov cev tau ua noobneej rua tuabneeg pum.
