Zaajqha 20 – Chivkeeb Tshooj 20

Uale Vaajtswv Has Zoo Dlua Obedience To God Is Better

Ua tuabneeg nyob mas txawm yug tub paub Vaajtswv hab paub Vaajlugkub zoo lawm los muaj ntau zag yug tseem txav txim sab ua tej yaam kws cuamtshuam Vaajlugkub hab. Thaum teebmeem tshwmsim tuaj kuj tsi tsimnyog yug chim hab tusab rua Vaajtswv vim tsi yog tim Vaajtswv tabsis yog tim yug.

Nyob huv Chivkeeb tshooj 21, peb yuav kawm txug Anplahaas. Nwg los kuj tau txav txim sab ua tej yaam kws tsi hum Vaajtswv sab hab ntsib kev nyuaj sab ntshuv plawv lug ntawm nwg kev txav txim sab. Nyeem kuas taagnrho Chivkeeb tshooj 21 uantej teb cov lug nug nuav.

As sinful human beings, even though we have known God and have known the Bible, many times, we decide to do things that are contrary to the Word of God. When trouble comes we have no rights to be angry at God or be disappointed with Him because it is not of His doing but ours.

In Genesis 21, we will study about Abraham. He also made decision to do things that were opposing to the will of God, resulting in a very distressful situation. Read the whole chapter of Genesis 21 before answering these questions.

1. Nyeem Chivkeeb 12:1-4, hab nyeem Chivkeeb 21:1-5. Thaum Vaajtswv coglug rua Anplahaas has tas nwg yuav dlhau moog ua ib haiv tuabneeg coob-coob moog txug rua thaum kws Anplahaas tau thawj tug tub yog pistsawg xyoo?

Read Genesis 12:1-4, and Genesis 21:1-5. How many years have passed from the time God made a promise that Abraham will become a great nation to the time when his son was born?

2. Thaum pum tej yaam zoo le nuav tshwmsim ua rua koj tso sab rua Vaajtswv le caag ntawm koj lub neej?

Having seen things like this happened, how do you trust God in your life?

3. Anplahaas muab tug mivtub lxaj ua kevcai txav thaum twg hab ua pluag noj thaum twg? (Nqe 4 thiab 8).

When did Abraham circumcised Isaac and when did he make the feast? (Verses 4 and 8).

4. Vim le caag Anplahaas txhaj muab nwg tug namyau Hankas hab nwg tug tub xaa tawm? (Nqe 9-14).

What made Abraham decide to send his wife Hagar and her son away? (Verses 9-14).

5. Nyob huv Chivkeeb 15:1-4, Vaajtswv tub rovqaab coglug meej rua Anplahaas lawm tas nwg yuavtsum muaj tub muaj ki xwb, tabsis nyob huv Chivkeeb 16:1-4, Anplahaas tseem yuav namyau lawm, vim nwg ntshai tsaam tsi muaj tubki. Lug txug rua Chivkeeb tshooj 21, peb pum tas Anplahaas lub neej kws muaj nam-hlub namyau mas ntxhuv heev, txug qhov kws muab namyau hab nwg tug miv-nyuas laij tawm tsev. Koj xaav le caag txug qhov kws Vaajtswv tsim ib tug quaspuj rua ib tug txivneej hab qhov kws Moob pheej yuav namyau?

In Genesis 15:1-4, God promised Abraham that he will have children of his own, but in Genesis 16:1-4, he married his wife's slave girl Hagar, as his second wife. Now in Genesis 21, we see how difficult his life has become to the point that he had to send his wife Hagar and her son away. What do you think about the fact that God created one man for one woman and one woman for one man and the practice of polygamy in the Hmong culture?

6. Tej yaam kws Anplahaas ua yuamkev nuav qha koj le caag txug kev noog Vaajtswv lug lossis ua le Vaajtswv has?

What have you learned from the mistake that Abraham made regarding obedience to God?

Ua tuabneeg nyob mas Vaajtswv yeej muaj homphaj rua yug lub neej lawm, tabsis yug tseem pheej muaj yug homphaj hab. Tej thaus kws muaj tej yaam zoo tshwmsim rua ib tug tuabneeg, Moob pheej has tas, "Tug ntawd mas nwg muaj moo kawg!" Lu lug "muaj moo" txhais le caag? Yog ua caag tej tug muaj moo, tej tug tsi muaj moo?

Kuv pum le nuav: Tug tuabneeg kws muaj moo yog tug kws nwg tej homphaj tsi cuamtshuam Vaajtswv tej homphaj. Tabsis tug kws tsi muaj moo yog tug kws npaaj tau nwg tej homphaj cuamtshuam tej kws Vaajtswv tub npaaj rua nwg lawm. Yaam kws nwg npaaj rua nwg tugkheej ntawd yuav coj nwg moog ntsib teebmeem. Thaum ntsib teebmeem lawm, suav-dlawg txhaj has tas, "Aub, yawm ntawd mas moov phem kawg."

Vim yug tsi paub tas Vaajtswv tub npaaj dlaabtsi rua yug lawm, yogle, yuav ua caag yug txhaj paub npaaj yug lub neej? Lu lug teb yog le nuav: (1) Npaaj ua tej yaam kws tsi cuamtshuam Vaajlugkub, hab (2) Txawm yug npaaj muaj homphaj los yug has rua Vaajtswv tas, "Vaajtswv, thov kuas moog lawv le koj sab nyam xwb." Paajlug 16:9 has le nuav:

"Ib leej tuabneeg nraaj nwg txuj hau kev, tabsis tug Tswv yog tug coj nwg rhais kaujrnam." ("In his heart a man plans his course, but the Lord determines his steps").
