Zajqhia 21 – Chivkeeb Tshooj 22

Muab Yam Zoo Fij Rau Vajtswv Give Your Best To God

Tus neeg yus hlub tshaj yus thiaj muaj peevxwm yuav tau yam khoom zoo tshaj pub nws, thiab yog nws kom yus ua dabtsi los yeej zoo siab hlo ua li nws hais. Vajtswv yog tus hlub peb tshaj. Vajluskub hais tias Nws tsis suav txim rau peb raws li peb tej kev txhaum (Phau Nkauj 103:10). Nws yog tus ua tshavntuj losnag rau noob-neej peb thiaj khwv rau noj tau haus (Mathais 5:45).

Tabsis yog Vajtswv hais tias kom koj muab yam uas koj nyiam tshajplaws ntawm koj lub neej lossis tus neeg uas koj hlub tshaj plaws ntawm koj txoj sia pub rau Vajtswv no koj yuav ua li cas? Vajluskub hais tias Anplahas yog Vajtswv tus phoojywg (Yakaunpaus 2:23). Nyob rau zaj qhia hnuv no peb yuav kawm txog qhov uas Vajtswv kom Anplahas muab ib yam zoo fij rau Vajtswv. Qhov uas Vajtswv kom Anplahas ua no yog yam uas nyuaj tshajplaws. Txawm li ntawd los Anplahas kuj muaj peevxwm ua tau li Vajtswv hais. Nyeem kom tagnrho Chivkeeb tshooj 22, uantej teb cov lus nug no.

To those whom we love the most, we are able to give them the best gift and whatever they want us to do we are willing to do it. God loves us the most. He does not punish us according to our sins (Psalm 103:10). He causes the sun to rise and the rain to fall on the righteous and unrighteous (Matt. 5:45).

But if God asked you to give what you cherish the most and the person whom you love the most to Him, what would you do? The Bible says that Abraham is the friend of God (James 2:23). In this lesson, we will study about God asking Abraham to give Him something good. What God asked of him to do is one of the most difficult things to do. But Abraham was able to do it. Read the whole chapter 22 of Genesis before answering these questions.

1. Vajtswv hais tias kom Anplahas ua dabtsi? (Nqe 1-2).

What did God ask Abraham to do? (Verses 1-2).

2. Thaum hnov Vajtswv hais li ntawd, Anplahas ua li cas? (Nqe 3-10)

What did Abraham do in response to God's command? (Verses 3-10).

3. Vajtswv cheem Anplahas li cas? (Nqe 11-14).

What did God do to intervene? (Verses 11-14).

4. Vim Anplahas muaj peevxwm ua tau li Vajtswv hais, Vajtswv txaus siab heev thiab coglus yuav ua dabtsi rau Anplahas? (Nqe 15-19).

Because Abraham was able to do as God commanded, what did God promise him? (Verses 15-19).

5. Cov neeg uas muaj kev phoojywg zoo yog cov uas muaj coojpwm sib thooj thiab muaj cuabkav ib yam. Qhov uas Anplahas thiab Vajtswv ua tau phoojywg yog vim nkawd muaj coojpwm thiab muaj peevxwm ua ib yam tshwjxeeb uas lwm tus tsis muaj peevxwm ua tau. Koj puas xav tau hais tias qhov ntawd yog dabtsi?

Often, people who have similar characters and abilities become good friends. The reason why Abraham was able to become a friend of God was because only God and Abraham were able to do something that no one else could do. What was it?

6. Tibneeg feem coob dhau tsis tau mus ua Vajtswv li phoojywg vim sawvdaws tsis muaj peevxwm fij yam zoo tshajplaws rau Vajtswv lossis tso tsis tau tus uas lawv hlub tshajplaws rau Vajtswv siv. Koj xav tias txij no mus, yam zoo tshaj uas koj txiav txim siab yuav muab pub rau Vajtswv yog dabtsi?

Most people are not able to become friends of God because they are unable to give what is best to God nor be able to dedicate the one whom they love the most for God's service. What would be the best that you can offer to God from now on?

Coob leej ntseeg tias lub roob lossis cov roob Mulyas (Moriah) hauv Chivkeeb 22:2, yog lub roob uas ib txhiab tawm xyoo tomqab, Vajntxwv Xalumoos ua lub tuamtsev rau.

Nyob hauv Chivkeeb 22:12-13, Vajtswv muab tus laug yaj los rau Anplahas tua hloov nws tus tub qhov chaw. Raws li totaub, Mulyas tsis yog ib lub roob xwb, tabsis yog ib phab tojroob. Cov tojroob ntawd yog cov uas ntau xyoo tomqab, Vajtswv tus tub Yexus tau raug dai rau saum ntoo dajteg hloov peb sawvdaws chaw. Nws tuag hloov peb chaw ib yam li tus laug yaj tuag hloov Anplahas tus tub lxaj chaw.
