## Zaajqha 24 – Chivkeeb Tshooj 25

### Anplahaas Tuag The Death of Abraham

Ua ib leej tuabneeg nyob, peb tsuas xaav nov lub moo nyob xwb, tsi xaav nov lub moo tuag. Txawm le ntawd los txhua tug tuabneeg kws tau yug lug lawm yuavtsum tau tuag xwb txhaj taag. Txawm yog tej tug tuabneeg le Methuxelas kws nyob txug 969 xyoo los thaus kawg nwg kuj tuag lawm hab (Chivkeeb 5:27). Tomqaab ib tug tuabneeg tuag lawm, luas has dlaabtsi txug nwg? Nyob rua huv Chivkeeb tshooj 25 nuav peb yuav kawm txug thaus Anplahaas tuag. Koj nyeem kuas taagnrho Chivkeeb 25:1-18 uantej teb cov lug nug nuav.

*As human beings, we would like to hear the news of someone living; we don't want to hear that he/she has died. But every person who has been born must die. Even the one who lived to be 969 years like Methuselah, at the end, he also died (Gen. 5:27). After a person has died what do people normally talk about him/her? In Genesis 25, we will study about the death of Abraham. Read Genesis 25:1-18 before you answer the following questions.*

*After a person has died, people would speak about that person. In verses 1-6, and 12-18, what does the Bible speak about Abraham?*

*What does the Bible speak about Abraham in verses 7-8?*

*Also, in verses 9-11, what does the Bible speak about Abraham? ’*

4. Yisamayees yog Anplahaas tug tub hlub kws tug namyau Isziv yug rua nwg. Tabsis nyob huv Chivkeeb 21:8-21, qha has tas thaus Anplahaas tug namhlub Xalas yug tau lxaj lawm, Xalas hab Anplahaas tau muab namyau hab nwg tug tub Yisamayees xaa tawm lossis laij tawm. Tabsis thaus Anplahaas tuag lawm, nwg tug tub Yisamayees tsua rov tuaj saib hab ua kevcai plujtuag rua nwg txiv. Yisamayees xaav le caag thaus ntawd?

*Ishmael was Abraham’s first son from his Egyptian wife. But in Genesis 21:8-21, after Abraham’s wife Sarah gave birth to Isaac, Sarah and Abraham sent Ismhael and his mother away. Now that Abraham has died, Ishmael came back to help with the funeral. What did Ishmael think or feel?*

5. Yog koj txiv tau muab koj tso nrug nam moog lawm thaus koj tseem yau. Nwg nuav koj hlub tav txiv hab koj muab cuab muaj yig lawm. Koj yuav xaav le caag hab ua le caag? Koj yuav ua le caag?

*Supposed that your father sent you away with your mother when you were small. Now that you have grown up and have your own family, what would you think? What will you do?*

Thaus ib tug tuabneeg tuag lawm, hab thaus puab ua kevcai paam tuag rua nwg, cov txheebze yuav has qee yaam txug tug kws tau tuag lawm, xwsle:

1. Nwg muaj noobnyoog le caag
2. Nwg muaj tsawg tug quaspuj lossis quasyawg
3. Nwg muaj mivnyuas coob le caag hab tej xeebntxwv pistsawg leej; yog tej mivnyuas hab xeebntxwv tuaj, luas tseem kuas sawv rua suavdlawg pum
4. Yuav muab nwg lub cev coj moog zais rua qhovtwg

Ib yaam zoo kws suavdlawg yuav tau xyum yog le nuav. Thaus tug tuabneeg ntawd tseem ua neej nyob, txawm nwg tau ua tej yaam rua lwm tug mob sab hab tu sab le caag los xij, zag nuav nwg tau taag sim neej lawm, cov nyob yuav tau rov lug sis hluv. Qhov ntawd yog qhov kws Yixamayees ua qauv tau zoo.
