Zaajqha 26 – Chivkeeb Tshooj 26

Ua Phoojywg Nrug Vaajtswv Hab Nrug Tuabneeg Friendship With God and Men

Nyob huv 1 Kaulithus 5:9-10, Vaajlugkub has tas yog peb yuav cais ntawm ntawm cov tuabneeg nplajteb kws ua txhum tes kawg peb yuav tau tawm huv lub nplajteb nuav moog xwb. Thaus peb tseem ua neej nyob huv lub nplajteb nuav, muaj ntau zag peb yuav muaj teebmeem nrug tuabneeg nplajteb, yogle, peb yuav tau tsim kuas muaj kev phoojywg.

Nyob rua huv Chivkeeb tshooj 26 nuav peb yuav kawm txog lxaj lub neej kws nrug cov tuabneeg Filitees nyob hab tej kev phoojywg kws nwg tsim muaj nrug cov tuabneeg ntawd. Nyeem kuas taagnrho Chivkeeb tshooj 26, uantej teb cov lug nug nuav.

In 1 Corinthians 5:9-10, the Bible says that if we want to be separated from immoral people we have to leave this world. While we live in the world, we will have problems with people, so building friendship with them is important.

In Genesis 26, we will study about Isaac who lived among the Philistines and the relationship that he built with those people. Read the whole chapter of Genesis 26 before answering these questions.

1. Nyeem Chivkeeb 12:10-13; nyeem Chivkeeb 20:1-3; nyeem Chivkeeb 26:1-11. Thaum muaj ib tug tuabneeg ua ib yaam dlaatsi le nwg nam nwg txiv tau ua lawm, peb nov Moob has tas yog “yoog noob.” Thaus nyeem txug peb zaaj nuav, koj pum tas qhov nuav tseeb le caag rua lxaj lub neej?

Read Genesis 12:10-13; read Genesis 20:1-3; read Genesis 26:1-11. When someone does something similar to what his/her parents have done, the Hmong used to say that he/she “conforms to the seed.” Reading about these three stories, what character do you see in Isaac that was also found in his father Abraham?

2. Yog muaj ib tug coojpwm tsi zoo kws koj muaj tabsis koj tsi xaav kuas tug coojpwm ntawd poob rua koj tej mivnyuas, tug coojpwm ntawd yog tug zoo le caag?

If there is a bad character in you that you wish it would not pass on to your children, what is that character?

3. Ixaj dlhau moog ua tuabneeg muaj nyaj vim yog Vaajtswv foom moov rua nwg xwb (nqai 12-14). Ua tuabzoo xaav saib yaam kws koj ib txwm tsi muaj tabsis Vaajtswv tau foom moov rua koj nwg nua koj txhaj muaj, yaam ntawd yog dlaabtsi?

Isaac became wealthy in the land of the Philistines because God blessed him (verses 15-22). What do you have now that you did not have before because God has blessed you?

4. Thaus cov tuabneeg Filitees pum tas Ixaj lub neej zoo hab muaj txag npluanuj, puab txawm pib ua phem rua nwg (nqai 15-22). Nwg tsi ua phem pauj phem le, tabsis cale tshais chaw ib qhov dlhau ib qhov xwb. Tej thaum raug luas ua phem le ntawd rua koj, koj ibtxwm ua le caag?

When the Philistines saw that Isaac became wealthy, they began to oppress him (verses 15-22). He did not retaliate but moved on. When being treated unfairly by others what is your habit of response?

5. Yuav ua lub neej kaaj sab nrug Vaajtswv yog yuavtsum ruaj sab rua Vaajtswv tej lug cog tseg. Ntawm nqai 23-25, Vaajtswv coglug le caag rua lxaj?

To live a healthy spiritual life is to trust the promises of God. In verses 23-25, what did God promise Isaac?

6. Yuav ua lub neej thaajyeeb nrug lwm lub tebchaws los yuavtsum yog muaj kev sis coglug nrug luas tuabyaam nkaus. Ntawm nqai 26-30, lxaj muaj kev coglug nrug Anpimelej le caag? Thaus coglug nrug lwm haiv tuabneeg hab muaj nojhaus ua kev zoo sab le ntawd yaam kws yuav tau ceevfaaj yog dlaabtsi?

To live at peaceful with other countries we must have agreement with them as well. In verses 26-30, what agreement did Isaac have with the Abimelech? What caution should be made when celebrating the treaty with a party?



Malakaus 12:3031 has tas peb yuavtsum hlub Vaajtsv hab hlub kwvtij zejzog. Yuav hlub tau Vaajtsv yog yuavtsum muaj kev phoojywg nrug Vaajtsv, hab yuav hlub tau kwvtij zejzog yog yuavtsum muaj kev phoojywg nrug puab. Tsi yoojyim rua yug ua phem rua yug tej phoojywg. Saib tug ntoo dlaajteg, koj yuav pum tas tug ntoo kws sawv huv peg teb moog rua sau ntuj pev txug kev phoojywg ntawm yug nce moog rua ntawm Vaajtsv, hab qhov taavtoj yog kev phoojywg ntawm yug moog rua kwvtij zejzog.

Pajlug 18:24 has tas, “Tug tuabneeg kws muaj phoojywg coob tej zag yuav pemsij rua tej phoojywg ntawd teg, tabsis muaj ib tug phoojywg kws ncawg yug tshaaj le tej kwvtij.” Thaum muaj phoojywg coob, qee tug yog phoojywg tseeb tabsis qee tug yuav yog phoojywg cuav. Thaum noj tsau haus qaug ceevfaaj tsaam tug phoojywg cuav txov yug.
