Zajqhia 9 – Chivkeeb Tshooj 12

Alas Raug Vajtswv Hu Abram Was Called By God

Ua neej nyob lub ntiajteb no ces yog ua neej taugkev, ua neej tshais chaw. Peb txhua tus puavleej tau tshais chaw. Zaum tshais chaw mus deb los muaj, zaum mus ze los muaj. Txhua zaus peb tshais chaw puavleej yog muaj homphiaj lossis muaj kev ntshaw kom lub neej tomntej zoo dua lub qub. Muaj ntau zaus yog peb tshais mus rau tej qhov chaw uas peb paub. Tabsis muaj ntau zaus peb ciali mus rau tej qhov chaw lossis tej lub tebchaws uas peb tsis paub li.

Nyob hauv Chivkeeb tshooj 12, peb yuav kawm txog ib tug txivneej uas nws raug Vajtswv hu thiab ciali tshais chaw mus rau ib lub tebchaws uas nws tsis tau paub dua. Nyem Chivkeeb tshooj 12:1-9, uantej teb cov lus nug no.

Life on earth is a pilgrimage, moving from one place to another. All of us have relocated. Whether moving to a place near by or to a place far away, we all have moved. There is always a reason or a goal that propels us to make the move, and often, it is for a better life. Sometimes, we move to a place that we know. But other times, we move to a place or country that we do not know.

In Genesis 12, we will study about a man who was called by God and moved to a country that he did not know. Read Genesis 12:1-9, before answering these questions.

1. Vajtswv samhwm li cas rau Alas? (Nqe 1).

What command did God give to Abram? (Vs. 1-4).

2. Vajtswv coglus dabtsi rau Alas? Sau txhua yam uas Vajtswv coglus (Nqe 2-3).

What promises did God make to Abram? List all the promises (Vs. 2-3).

3. Alas muaj hnuvnyoog pistsawg xyoo thiab nws tshais chaw mus rau lub tebchaws hu li cas? (Nqe 4-5).

How old was Abram and to what country did he move? (Vs. 4-5).

4. Yog ua cas Alas ho paub tias tebchaws ntawd yog lub uas Vajtswv xav kom nws nyob? (Nqe 6-7).

How did Abram know that that country was the one God wanted him to live? (Vs. 6-7).

5. Alas tshais chaw txog twg los nws pehawm Vajtswv qhov ntawd. Ntawm ob thaj chaw uas nws mus txog no, nws tsim dabtsi los ua chaw pehawm Vajtswv? (Nqe 7-8).

Wherever Abram settled, he worshiped God there. In these two places, what did he build to worship God? (Vs. 7-8).

6. Yog ua cas yus thiaj paub tias zaum no yog Vajtswv hu yus kom ua ib yam dabtsi lossis kom yus tshais chaw rau lwm qhov?

How do you know that God is calling you to do something or to move somewhere?

7. Sau ib yam uas koj ua lossis qhov chaw ua koj mus es koj ntseeg tias yog Vajtswv kom koj ua li ntawd.

Write one thing that you did or a place that you went to, knowing that God was leading you.

Vajluskub tsis qhia hais tias Vajtswv hais lus li cas rau Alas – ua npausuav rau nws, ua yogtoog rau nws, hais lus rau nws hnov, lossis tshoov nws siab xwb. Txawm li cas los Vajtswv yeej tau ua tej yam uas nws paub meej tias yog Vajtswv hais lus rau nws. Kuv ntseeg tias thaum Alas paub meej yog thaum nws pom tej yam uas Vajtswv tau coglus ntawd tshwmsim tuaj.

Tiam no txhua yam uas peb ua yuavtsum muaj li no: (1) tsis cuamtshuam Vajluskub, (2) ua rau Vajtswv lub npe nrov ncha, thiab (3) pab tau lwm tus. Yog txhua yam peb ua dhos cov no ces txawm peb tsis hnov Vajtswv hais lus los peb yeej ruaj siab tau tias nyaj yuav haum Vajtswv siab lawm thiab.
