Zajqhia 13 – Chivkeeb Tshooj 15

Rov Coglus Dua thiab Qhia Txog Yav Tomntej Reconfirmed the Promise and Foretold the Future

Feem coob ntawm peb sawvdaws yuav nco tau hais tias muaj tej tug neeg tau coglus yuav ua yam ub yam no rau yus, tabsis ntau xyoo tomqab, nws ciali tsis ncoqab tej lus ntawd lawm. Yam nws tau coglus tias yuav ua rau yus, nws ciali tsis ua.

Nyob hauv Chivkeeb 12:2, Vajtswv tau coglus rau Anplas tias kom nws mloog Vajtswv lus thiab mus rau ib lub tebchaws uas Vajtswv yuav qhia rau nws. Vajtswv yuav pub kom nws dhau mus ua ib haiv neeg uas coob heev. Thaum ntawd Anplas nkawd tsis tau muaj ib tug menyuam li. Anplas ua raws nraim li Vajtswv hais thiab tau mus rau lub tebchaws uas Vajtswv kom nws mus. Tabsis twb tau ntau xyoo tomqab lawm, Anplas nkawd ob niamtxiv tseem tsis muaj menyuam li thiab. Puas yog Vajtswv tsis ncoqab lawm?

Nyeem kom tagnrho Chivkeeb tshooj 15, uantej teb cov lus nug no.

Most of us would be able to remember that there were people who promised that they would do this or do that for us but years later, they forgot their promise. What they have said that they would do, they did not do it.

In Genesis 12:2, God promised Abram that if he would be obedient and go to a country that God will show him, God will bless him and make him a great nation. At that time, Abram and his wife were childless. Abram obeyed and went to a country that God showed him. But years later, Abram and his wife were still childless. Did God forget His promise?

Read the whole chapter of Genesis 15 before answering these questions.

1. Thaum Vajtswv rovqab los ua yogtoog rau Anplas pom thiab nrog nws tham, Anplas hais rau Vajtswv tias nkawd ob niamtxiv tseem tsis muaj menyuam li, yog nkawd tuag thiab ncaim ntiajteb lawm, ntshe nkawd tus tub qhe uas yog neeg Damaxes yuav tau tagnrho nkawd lub cuabtam mus uas nws tug. When God appeared and spoke to Abram again in a vision, Abram mentioned that he and wife were still without a child and that if they passed away, what they had would belong to their servant Eliezer of Damascus. What did God say to reconfirm his promise? (Verses 1-5).

2. Thaum Anplas ntseeg li Vajtswv hais, Vajtswv suav hais tias Anplas yog tus neeg zoo li cas? (Nqe 6).

When Abram believed what God said, what did God credit him? (Verse 6).

3. Peb muaj ntau leej yeej niajhmo npausuav, tabsis tej npausuav ntawd tsis muaj qabhau dabtsi. Sau ib qhov npausuav uas koj muaj tabsis ciali tshwm los ua qhov tseeb, uas koj ntseeg tias yog Vajtswv qhia koj uantej.

4. Thaum Anplas tsaugzog heev lawm, Vajtswv los hais rau nws hauv npausuav tias yuav muaj dabtsi tshwmsim rau Anplas cov xeebntxwv yav tomntej? (Verses 12-16).

When Abram was in deep sleep, what did God tell him that would happen to his descendants in the future? (Verses 12-16).

4. Thaj av uas Vajtswv coglus rau Anplas tias Nws yuav muab rau Anplas cov xeebntxwv yog ib thaj av uas twb muaj lwm haiv neeg nyob lawm. Sau tej haiv neeg ntawd tej npe rau ntawm no. (Nqe 17-21).

The land that God promised to give to Abram's descendants belonged to other nations at that time. List the names of the nations that lived in that land. (Verses 17-21).

5. Nyob hauv Tej Lus Qhia 1:9 hais tias tsis muaj ib yam tshiab nyob hauv lub ntiajteb no li. Yam yus qhuas hais tias yog yam tshiab los twb xub muaj yav thaum ub lawm. Tej teejtug uas yus muaj los feem ntau twb yog lwm tus li uantej dhau los ua yus li. Txawm li ntawd los yog poob los rau yus tes ces twb yog Vajtswv pub rau yus lawm. Sau rau ntawm no tej yam khoom qub uas koj muaj tamsim no tabsis twb yog lwm tus li uantej lawm. Thiab yog koj tseem txaus siab rau tej khoom ntawd, coj mus tham qhia koj pab Care Group thiab ua Vajtswv tsaug rau tej ntawd.

1. Vajtswv tau coglus li cas lawm, Nws yuav ua kom tiav li ntawd. Txawm peb tsis ncoqab lawm los Vajtswv yeej tseem nco. Vajtswv coglus rau Anplas tias nws poj-niam yuav muaj menyuum ces txawm muaj li ntawd tiag. Anplas nkawd yug tau ib tug tub hu ua Ixaj. Vajtswv coglus tias Anplas cov xeebntxwv yuav poob mus ua cevqhev rau txawv tebchaws ces txawm tshwmsim li ntawd tiag. Lawv mus nyob tebchaws Iziv tau 430 xyoo. Vajtswv coglus tias Anplas covg xeebntxwv yuav los txeeb tau ntau haiv neeg tej tebchaws los ua lawv tug ces txawm tshwmsim li ntawd tiag.
2. Kev ntseeg yog kev ncaincees. Thaum Anplas ntseeg tias Vajtswv yuav ua li Vajtswv hais ces Vajtswv txawm suav hais tias Anplas yog neeg ncaincees. Tiamno los peb dhau tau ua neeg ncaincees tsis yog vim peb ua tau ncaincees tabsis vim peb ntseeg Vajtswv tus tub Yexus, ces Vajtswv suav tias peb ncaincees.
3. Yam uas yog lwm tus li yuav dhau los ua yus li yog yus mloog Vajtswv lus thiab ua li Nws hais. Tabsis yog yus tsis mloog Nws lus, yam yus muaj yuav poob mus ua lwm tus li. Vajtswv yog tus ua kom tshwmsim li ntawd.
