SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AGREEMENT

This document outlines the Terms and Conditions of all HAAC Scholarships. You must read these Terms and Conditions in their entirety before submitting the application. This document serves as if you are offered a scholarship and accepting such an offer. By signing it, you agreed to these Terms and Conditions as listed below.

- 1. A minimum of full time or 12 credits per semester is required to be eligibility for the scholarship.
- 2. A scholarship applicant must be a HAAC member, who is currently enrolled at or accepted to an accredited college or university.
- 3. Scholarships will be awarded each year and paid out equally between fall and spring semesters of each academic year.
- 4. A scholarship recipient who reduces his/her course work to less than full time or 12 credits after registration shall only be entitled to the value of the scholarship as determined by the prorated cost of tuition calculated from the withdrawal date.
- 5. A scholarship recipient must re-apply for scholarship award each academic year, if funds are available.
- 6. The scholarship award will be sent to the college and only be used for tuition fees, room and board, and books.
- 7. A scholarship recipient must not be on probationary throughout the academic year. If a scholarship recipient does not meet the minimum requirement, his/her scholarship award for the subsequent semester will be suspended.
- 8. Scholarship award for the subsequent semester will be terminated if a scholarship recipient terminates or changes church membership.
